Great martial artists covering dozens of martial arts systems, have come to Camp Danzan Ryu from around the world to teach and share

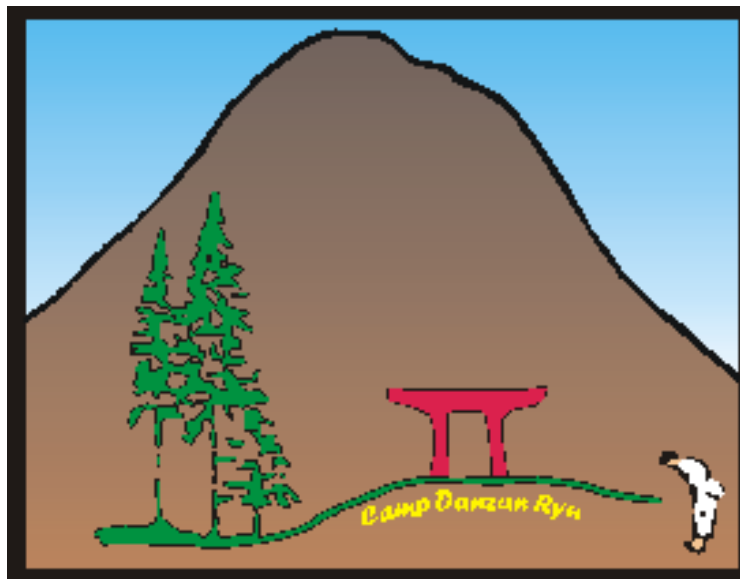
